



Centradenia 'Blushing Cascade'

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Billows of light shell pink blossoms provide a dramatic accent to the trailing, bronzy red leaves. Spectacular fall foliage of orange and crimson and nearly nonstop blooming add to the performance.

USES

This very hardy annual holds color well into fall, tolerates temperatures close to freezing, and may overwinter in areas where winters are very mild. It looks great in mixed baskets and large containers, or all by itself. It can also be used as a shrubby landscape annual for sites with partial shade and moist soil.

GARDENER TIPS

- Plant in well-drained soil in full sun or partial shade.
- Water generously.
- Mature plants may become woody near the crown. Trim regularly to keep plants full, but plants should recover well from a harder trim if needed.

- Height: 18–24"/24"
- Spread: 18"
- Bloom: summer–frost
