



## Coreopsis 'Sienna Sunset'

### GENERAL DESCRIPTION

A sport of *C. 'Creme Brulee'*, this large, burnt sienna daisy lightens to orange as it matures. A thread-leaf type, it has finely textured foliage and blooms all summer. Attracts butterflies but resists deer.

### USES

'Sienna Sunset' puts an interesting flower color in the front or middle of a perennial border or in mixed containers. It's outstanding planted in masses and makes a pretty cut flower.

### GARDENER TIPS

- Plant in moderate to dry soil.
- Plant in full sun.
- Provide an average amount of water during hot spells.
- Remove spent flowers to encourage continuous blooming.

### PLANT DATA

- Height: 16–20"/20"
- Spread: 24"
- Bloom time: Jun–Sep
- USDA Zone: 5(-20°)
