



Eryngium 'Jade Frost'

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Interesting, violet blue globes surrounded by spiny bracts rise on stems above variegated rosettes. The blue green leaves have creamy white margins that are tinged with a rosy blush in cool weather. It makes an intriguing cut flower—prickly, but pretty.

USES

'Jade Frost' is perfect in hot, dry borders, rockeries and cool season containers. It is perfect for late summer and fall interest, but plants have appeal during several seasons.

GARDENER TIPS

- Grow in full sun for the best foliage and flower color.
- Plant in well-drained soil and allow to dry thoroughly between waterings.
- Fertilize regularly.
- 'Jade Frost' has very few pest or disease problems, but watch for mites during hot summer weather.
