



## *Euphorbia* 'Ascot Rainbow'

### GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Variegated, sage green, gold and lime foliage with flowers that repeat the color pattern. Leaves are tinged with pink in cool weather. Compact and slightly spreading, this variety is very heat and drought tolerant.

### USES

'Ascot Rainbow' is tough and beautiful in borders and containers, but especially useful in any environment that is hot and dry.

### GARDENER TIPS

- Plant in full sun with good soil drainage.
- Feed sparingly. A slow-release fertilizer in the spring is ideal.
- Remove spent flowers.
- Although it's naturally compact, remove old flowering stems to promote an even bushier form.
- Avoid contact with the milky sap which can be a skin irritant.
