



Euphorbia 'Ruby Glow'

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Almost black, with bright red new growth, 'Ruby Glow' is evergreen, compact and bushy. The leaf reverse and stems are also red, while chartreuse bracts provide a vivid color contrast. *PlantHaven; hybridized by David Tristram.*

USES

This very dark *Euphorbia* is stunning in perennial borders, rock gardens and patio pots. As an evergreen, it provides year-round foliage color.

GARDENER TIPS

- Plant in full sun for best leaf color, although it tolerates partial shade.
- Plant in dry, sandy soil but tolerates heavier soils if well drained.
- Feed sparingly. A slow-release fertilizer in the spring is ideal.
- Remove spent flowers.
- Although it's normally compact, remove old flowering stems to promote an even bushier form.
- Avoid contact with the milky sap which can be a skin irritant.
