



Euphorbia 'Shorty'

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Named for its stature, 'Shorty' does everything except fall short on performance. The beautiful, blue green foliage provides a graceful textural element that delights in containers, borders or rockeries. Foliage mellows to a softer green, tinged with glowing, rosy tips in fall. Colder weather intensifies the color. Bright yellow flower heads appear in late winter or early spring and are a sharp contrast to the fresh new growth.

USES

'Shorty' makes a great specimen plant in borders or rockeries. Since it looks good year-round, it can provide an evergreen accent in mixed containers.

GARDENER TIPS

- Plant in full sun, in average, well-drained soil.
- Although *Euphorbias* are drought tolerant when established, provide water during prolonged dry periods.
- Fertilize sparingly.
- Remove spent blooms.
- Avoid contact with the milky sap which can be a skin irritant.
