



Helleborus 'Silver Lace'

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Grown for its handsome, silvery blue foliage, 'Silver Lace' creates a shimmer of color. Leaves are serrated, with an understated textural interest, and the plant has a compact habit that makes it less inclined to be leggy. The foliage is attractive all year, but when pale green flowers appear in late winter, it is a fabulous accompaniment to Primroses, Pansies or early spring bulbs. *PlantHaven*.

USES

A showy foliage plant, 'Silver Lace' has flowers that stay attractive from February through April. It is perfect in shade and woodland gardens, but also makes a great centerpiece in large, mixed containers.

GARDENER TIPS

- Plant in light shade with protection from severe weather.
- Plant in fertile, humus-rich, moist, well-drained soil.
- Water generously.
- Mulch in the fall in cold winter areas.
- Remove older, shabby leaves to keep plant looking fresh.
- When fully faded, cut back flowers and oldest stems to the soil line.
