



Veronica 'Eveline'



GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Dense flower spikes on sturdy upright plants provide rich rosy purple color in summer and autumn. Hummingbirds and butterflies find the flowers quite attractive. When temperatures cool in fall, the dark green foliage turns red and purple.

USES

This *Veronica* does well in borders, rockeries or containers, and makes an excellent, long-lasting cut flower.

GARDENER TIPS

- Plant in full sun.
- Grow in average—not rich—soil that drains well.
- Provide ample water.
- To extend blooming, remove spent flowers by cutting them close to the base of the plant.

- Bloom time: Jun–Aug
- USDA Zone: 4(-30°)
