This outstanding series brings magical, new life to winter and early spring-blooming Hellebores. Flowering the first year, they are long blooming, with lots of buds and blossom. Large flowers are forward facing and can be enjoyed indoors as winter and holiday decorations, and later planted outside as a long-lived perennial. Deer resistant, these selections make a good ground cover and are choice perennials for shady borders. Joshua

Height: 12–15"/15"

Spread: 17"

Bloom time: Nov–Dec

USDA Zone: 4(-30°)

Lovely, slightly fragrant, upward-facing white blooms age to light green. Very early to flower. Foliage is a handsome dark green.

Jacob

Height: 9–12"/12"

Spread: 13"

Bloom time: Nov–Jan

USDA Zone: 4(-30°)

Numerous and long-lasting, pure white flowers bloom extremely early: a true Christmas Rose. Perfect as an indoor holiday decoration. Glossy, deep green foliage.

Josef Lemper

Height: 15–18"/18"

Spread: 21"

Bloom time: Dec–Feb

USDA Zone: 4(-30°)

Very large, virgin white blooms in December for amazing, midwinter flowering. Remarkably robust for superior garden performance.

Pink Frost

Height: 12–15"/15"

Spread: 24"

Bloom time: Jan–Mar

USDA Zone: 5(-20°)

An eruption of burgundy buds open to blossoms in soft pink shades that darken to rich hues as flowers age. As fresh blooms appear, the display across the spectrum from white to pink to red is stunning. Rich green foliage has red stems and veins and a silvery sheen marbled across the top.

Silvermoon

Height: 15–18"/18"

Spread: 21"

Bloom time: Jan–Mar

USDA Zone: 4(-30°)

Creamy white blossoms are tinged pink and mature to a dusky rose. Upright growth with silver leaves on rosy stems. Ideal for shady beds, borders and containers.

Green Corsican

Height: 18–24"/24"

Spread: 27"

Bloom time: Feb–Apr

USDA Zone: 5(-20°)

Loads of large, creamy white blossoms turn a fresh, lively green as they mature. Long-lasting flowers stand erect on strong stems. Attractive, shiny green foliage.
