GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Graceful flowers on long stems make Japanese *Anemones* a fine addition to the middle or back of the border. Blooming in fall, they provide good cut flowers, as well as garden interest.

- **'Honorine Jobert'**—large, single white flowers
- **'Pamina'**—semidouble, deep rose flowers
- **'Party Dress'**—huge, double, pink flowers
- **'Queen Charlotte'**—semidouble, pale pink flowers
- **'September Charm'**—single, rose pink flowers with dark pink reverse
- **'Whirlwind'**—large, semidouble, white flowers

USES

Japanese *Anemones* bring a fresh look to sunny or partially shaded beds and borders. Because they bloom later in the growing season, they are a great addition to a late summer or fall perennial program.

GROWER NOTES

The following information is based on our own experience with this crop in the Pacific Northwest. Growth will vary depending on location, climate, growing medium and cultural practices. As always, where chemical use is involved, read the labels, follow the instructions and practice careful trialing methods.

- Plant in late spring for green sales, or early summer for flowering pot sales.
- In areas with very hot summers, keep light shade on young plants.
- Be sure to plant crown at soil level and apply a preventative fungicide drench after transplant.
- To keep plants compact and less prone to crown or root problems, keep soil lightly moist, but do not overwater.
- Keep a watchful eye out for foliar nematodes and anthracnose, although tissue culture production has greatly reduced the incidence of these two major *Anemone* production problems. The best defense against foliar nematodes is monitoring, early detection and destruction of infected plants.
- Watch for caterpillars, which are easily controlled with a number of insecticides.
