## Salvia Sensation Series

### GENERAL DESCRIPTION

These perennial *Salvias*, although dwarf, are well-branched, strong growers and make nice pots quickly. All are profuse bloomers in soft colors and valued for a compact, tidy habit. Deer and rabbit resistant. *Hybridized by Florensis.*

- 'Sensation Rose'
- 'Sensation Sky Blue'

### USES

They perform well in perennial borders, rockeries and containers.

### GROWER NOTES

*The following information is based on our own experience with this crop in the Pacific Northwest. Growth will vary depending on location, climate, growing medium and cultural practices. As always, where chemical use is involved, read the labels, follow the instructions and practice careful trialing methods.*

- Grow in full sun and fast-draining soil that is allowed to dry thoroughly between waterings.
- Be aware that growth may be slow in early spring under cool conditions, but plants will quickly fill out and produce buds when the weather warms up. Fall planting may not provide finished plants any earlier than spring planting when grown outdoors.
- Use for late spring and early summer crops as they seldom need cutting back, and are tolerant of a wide range of growing conditions.
- Pests and disease are seldom a serious problem.
- Use larger plugs for faster spring finish.

### PLANT DATA

- Height: 12"/12"
- Spread: 12"
- Bloom time: May–Aug
- USDA Zone: 4(-30°)

### APPROXIMATE FINISH TIMES

- 4" from 128-cell liner: 8–10 weeks from spring transplant
- 4" from 128-cell liner: 28–32 weeks from fall transplant
- Gallon from 72-cell liner: 32 weeks from fall transplant
- Gallon from 72-cell liner: 10–12 weeks from spring transplant
