GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Bushy and clump forming, upright *Sedums* bloom in late summer and fall with large clusters of showy flowers beloved by bees.

- **Autumn Charm™**—green leaves edged in white, with rosy red flowers
- **Autumn Delight**—chartreuse leaves edged in blue green, with rosy flowers
- **Autumn Fire**—gray green leaves with rosy pink to salmon flowers
- **Autumn Joy**—green leaves with coppery pink flowers
- **Hab Gray**—smoky gray leaves with lemon yellow flowers
- **Matrona**—gray green leaves with pink flowers
- **Neon**—green leaves with deep rose pink flowers
- **Purple Emperor**—dark purple leaves with pink to purple flowers
- **Red Cauli**—blue green leaves with ruby red flowers
- **Sunset Cloud**—steel blue leaves with wine red flowers
- **Xenox**—dusky blue green leaves with soft pink flowers

USES

These *Sedums* are perfect for the larger rockery, middle of the border or as an accent plant in containers.

GROWER NOTES

The following information is based on our own experience with this crop in the Pacific Northwest. Growth will vary depending on location, climate, growing medium and cultural practices. As always, where chemical use is involved, read the labels, follow the instructions and practice careful trialing methods.

- Grow dry and with fairly low fertility for best foliage color and densest growth. Group with other low water-usage plants such as *Euphorbia* for best results.
- Pinch early in production to produce heavier branching, but 'Xenox' doesn't require pinching to keep stems from flopping. If desired, pinch when plants are about 8" tall, no later than mid June. Pinch back to 4–6", leaving 2–3 nodes to produce lateral branching.
- Space plants either at planting or before foliage begins to touch to promote sturdy, well-branched plants. Overcrowding produces weaker, softer shoots and plants may become floppy when pulled from flats for sale.
- Pests and diseases are not typically a problem with *Sedums*, but monitor plants for foliage spots or fungus during prolonged periods of wet weather or heavy overhead watering.
