## Campanula Ringsabell Series

### GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Bells with a perky scalloped edge are suspended from slender stems that rise above the medium green foliage. Compact and tidy, this *Campanula* series does not run rampant like others of its type, but spreads slowly. *Introduced by Amerinova.*

**'Ringsabell Indigo Blue'**—violet blue

**'Ringsabell Mulberry Rose'**—rose pink; rapid and robust grower

### USES

The Ringsabell *Campanulas* provide lovely summer color in borders, beds and containers, and may rebloom in the fall. Easy to grow with adequate moisture, their compact habit makes them an ideal addition to any perennial garden.

### GARDENER TIPS

- Choose a site in full sun or part shade.
- Plant in soil with good drainage.
- Place so that the crown is at soil level, no deeper.
- Keep evenly moist during the growing season.
- Watch for aphids during the growing season and mites in hot weather.

Spread: 15"

Bloom time: late spring–summer
