Panicum Shenandoah



Genus	Panicum
Variety	'Shenandoah'
Exposure	Full Sun
Height	36-48"
Spread	36"
Description	Green leaves in early summer turn burgundy by fall. Beadlike seed heads appear in midsummer. Plant in masses or as accent. Good for cutting, fresh or dried.
Care	Will tolerate most soil types. Keep well watered in hot weather. Cut back in early spring as new growth appears.
Bloom Time	Summer
