Tradescantia Osprey



Genus	Tradescantia
Variety	`Osprey'
Exposure	Full Sun to Part Shade
Height	18-24"
Spread	24"

Description Clusters of blue-eyed, white to pale blue, 3-petaled flowers on stiff stems above clumps of fleshy, bladelike leaves. Good in woodland gardens and perennial borders.

Care Prefers moist, fertile soil. Do not allow to dry out. Cut back hard after first flush of flowers. Divide clumps every 2-3 years.
