Genus Achillea

Variety 'King Edward'

Exposure Full Sun

Height 6-8"

Spread 12"

Description Small clusters of primrose yellow flowers sit atop a low carpet of fuzzy, olive green foliage. Use between stepping stones, as a small-area groundcover, or as edging.

Care Prefers light, well-drained soil with infrequent water, and tolerates hot, dry sites. Deadhead after flowering.
