## Lavatera Eye Catcher



<b>Genus</b>	Lavatera
<b>Variety</b>	'Eye Catcher'
<b>Exposure</b>	Full Sun to Part Shade
<b>Height</b>	50-70"
<b>Spread</b>	48"

**Description** Abundant rose pink hollyhock flowers with ruby eyes on a semi-evergreen shrub with soft, gray green, maple-like leaves and a tall, upright habit. Landscape or containers.

**Care** Easily grown in light, gritty soils with some humus. Drought tolerant once established. Prune to shape in late winter.
