Genus	Lavatera
Variety	'Eye Catcher'
Exposure	Full Sun to Part Shade
Height	50-70"
Spread	48"

Description Abundant rose pink hollyhock flowers with ruby eyes on a semi-evergreen shrub with soft, gray green, maple-like leaves and a tall, upright habit. Landscape or containers.

Care Easily grown in light, gritty soils with some humus. Drought tolerant once established. Prune to shape in late winter.
