## Spiraea Double Play Candy Corn



<b>Genus</b>	Spiraea
<b>Variety</b>	Double Play® Candy Corn®
<b>Exposure</b>	Full Sun to Part Shade
<b>Height</b>	18-24"
<b>Spread</b>	30"
<b>Description</b>	Early new growth is candy apple red, then turns pineapple yellow; later new growth is candy corn orange, all contrasting with dark purple flowers. Containers, borders.
<b>Care</b>	Easily grown in well-drained soil. Drought tolerant once established. Apply a slow-release fertilizer in spring. Trim after flowering.
<b>Bloom Time</b>	Late Spring
