Viburnum Blue Muffin



Genus	Viburnum
Variety	Blue Muffin®
Exposure	Full Sun to Part Shade
Height	5-7'
Spread	8'

Description Creamy flowers in flat-topped clusters give way to bird-attracting blue berries if a pollinizer is present. Multi-stemmed, deciduous shrub makes a fine screen or hedge.

Care Easily grown in well-drained soil with moderate water. Fertilize in spring. Prune after flowering, leaving flowers to form berries.
