Miscanthus Purpurascens



Genus	Miscanthus
Variety	'Purpurascens'
Exposure	Full Sun to Part Shade
Height	36-48"
Spread	72"

Description Clump-forming, ornamental grass noted for red-tinged summer blades that turn fiery orange in fall and burgundy in winter. White flower plumes. Specimen or accent.

Care Plant in well-drained soil and water regularly until established. Fertilize and cut foliage to near the ground in early spring.
