## Miscanthus Zebrinus



<b>Genus</b>	Miscanthus
<b>Variety</b>	`Zebrinus'
<b>Exposure</b>	Full Sun to Part Shade
<b>Height</b>	5-8'
<b>Spread</b>	6'

**Description** Yellow, horizontal bands decorate green, upright blades that arch gracefully, turning gold in fall and tan in winter. Bronze flower plumes. Specimen, accent, near ponds.

**Care** Plant in well-drained soil and water regularly until established. Fertilize and cut foliage to near the ground in early spring.

**Bloom Time** Late Summer- Winter
