## Nemesia Honey Red

<b>Genus</b>	Nemesia
<b>Variety</b>	Honey Red
<b>Exposure</b>	Full Sun to Part Shade
<b>Height</b>	12-14"
<b>Spread</b>	10"
<b>Description</b>	Small, early, dusky red snapdragon-like flowers with yellow throats. Long blooming season, but best in cool weather. Containers and landscape.
<b>Care</b>	Grow in well-drained soil with moderate water and fertilize every two weeks in pots. Cut back after spring flowering for a fall bloom.
<b>Bloom Time</b>	Spring- Early Fall
<b>Fragrant</b>	Y
<b>Patent</b>	Protected Variety
